Bach Festival Society Wins Seventh Annual LYNX Public Service Bus Award

Each of the selected nonprofits will have its logo painted on the Public Service Bus that will run normal routes in Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties, giving the twelve winners free exposure all over Central Florida. The bus will be in service for a year and is available for each of the twelve nonprofits to display at one of their events. "We're delighted that Lynx is recognizing the contribution of the nonprofit community in such a fantastic way. The Bach Festival Society is thrilled to have its logo included on this bus," said Betsy Gwinn, Executive Director.

The Public Service Bus was unveiled to the public at an awards ceremony at Amway Arena on May 1, 2008. This is the seventh year that LYNX has donated advertising space to nonprofit organizations. The winners were selected in a random drawing from nearly 100 entries received from organizations in all three counties.
